The Drought Assistance Fund offers \$50,000 interest free loans, for a period of seven years, repayment free for two years, to primary producers to help promote profitability and resilience.

Drought Transport Subsidies



\$70 million in Drought Transport Subsidies for 2019/20 which can be applied to the cost of transporting:

- » fodder
- » water to a property for stock or domestic use
- » stock to and from agistment
- » stock to sale or slaughter
- » from 1 July 2019 transporting farm chemicals, fertiliser & seed to farms

Farm Innovation Fund



\$1 billion in long term, low interest rate loans for NSW farmers for permanent on-farm infrastructure to improve farm productivity, manage adverse seasonal conditions and ensure long term sustainability.

Emergency Water



Emergency Water Infrastructure Rebate (EWIR) scheme is available to eligible primary producers who can claim rebates of up to \$25,000 on new purchases and installation costs of water infrastructure projects.
